Overview

Welcome to the Lionbridge Connector for Drupal 7 TMGMT (Connector). This Connector enables you to automate sending and retrieving content from Drupal 7 TMGMT to Lionbridge for translation, which dramatically reduces the effort required to create, maintain, and publish Web content in multiple languages.

Note: A separate Lionbridge Connector is available for Drupal 8 TMGMT.

What's New?

- In the **Add Translator** page, after selecting `Lionbridge Content API Connector` in the **Translator plugin** dropdown list, entering user credentials, and clicking **Connect**:
 - ▣ You can now select a default translation provider in the new **Provider configuration** dropdown list. This translation provider will be displayed by default when users send content out for translation.
 - ▣ You can use the new **Allow provider overrides** check box to determine whether users can change the translation provider when submitting jobs.
- You can now migrate from version 1.x of the Connector, which supported only the Lionbridge onDemand translation provider, to the current Connector version.
- To migrate from version 2.0 of the Connector to the current Connector version, you must complete the processing of all jobs in the older version, uninstall that version, and delete the corresponding folder from the server before installing the current Connector version.

Issues Fixed in This Release

Issue ID	Description
DRUPAL-20	Previously, when a translation provider was not properly configured, the corresponding error message was displayed in green. This has been resolved: In this scenario, the error message is now displayed in red, and it includes a link to the configuration page where the administrator can fix the configuration.
DRUPAL-33	The Reject Translation button was removed, because it had no associated functionality.
DRUPAL-35	<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ The Delete and Abort buttons are now available only when a job is in one of the following states:<ul style="list-style-type: none">▣ Unprocessed▣ Finished <p>The Delete and Abort buttons are <i>not</i> available in any of the other states, which occur when the job is actively in translation. If you click them, a warning is displayed, and you cannot proceed. Previously, these buttons were always available, but they did not function properly.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">■ In the Operations page, you can no longer perform bulk actions on any jobs that are actively in translation.

Issue ID	Description
DRUPAL-36	Previously, after selecting any content item under Config Entity and clicking Request translation , an error message was displayed. This issue has been resolved. You can now send out Config Entity content items for translation.
