Library Card Registration and Eligibility Policy

A. General Policy

- a. Examples of Photo ID
 - Valid Passport
 - Valid US military identification
 - Out-of-State driver's license
 - School ID
 - Employee or contractor photo ID card issued by a local, state or US government agency
- b. Examples of Proof of Residency
 - Vehicle registration card or title
 - Voter registration card
 - Utility or telephone bill
 - Check with printed name and address
 - Property tax bill
 - Utility bill or other official mail postmarked within the last 30 days
 - Lease agreement dated within the last 30 days
 - Electronic versions of utility bills, lease agreements or other official documents, dated within the last 30 days.

B. Statewide Borrowing Privileges

- 1. Any Maryland resident may borrow materials from any branch of the public library system in Maryland, subject to the current regulations of the individual system. A resident may be required to register in the public library system from which he or she wishes to borrow.
- 2. Anne Arundel County Public Library materials and materials belonging to other library systems may be returned to any public library in the state with the following exceptions:
 - a. 16mm films must be returned to the branch of the system where they were borrowed.
 - b. All Interlibrary loan materials must be returned to the library system where it was borrowed.

C. Library Card Profiles

The following cards types are eligible to customers in good standing:

1. PATRON

Library account's issued to customers 17 years or older.

2. CHILD

Child library cards *are* issued to customers from birth-16 years old, these users are not allowed to checkout rated R material.

3. VIRTUAL

Library accounts issued to customers who have applied for a card through our online registration process.
