Allow Only Attribute Pairs

A list of attribute pairs such as ou=education or cn=*barclay that at least one of must be met to allow ldap authentication. Enter one per line such as

```
ou=education
ou=engineering
```

Excluded Attribute Pairs

A list of attribute pairs such as ou=evil or cn=bad* that are not allowed to use ldap authentication. Containing any one of the following will disallow the user from authenticating via LDAP. Enter one per line such as

```
ou=evil
cn=bad*
```

- ☒ Disallow login and log the conflict
- ☐ Associate local account with the LDAP entry

What should be done if a local Drupal account already exists with the same login name.

☐ Require Admin Approval after Initial Logon

When a user authenticates via LDAP and it is a new account, start the account out as disabled and email the admin for it to be approved.

☐ Don't Create Drupal Accounts

Do not create Drupal accounts for LDAP authenticated users. Allow existing Drupal accounts to authenticate via LDAP. With this option, user accounts using LDAP authentication will need to be created before a user logs on.

[Email](#)**Email Behavior ***

- ☐ Allow users to overwrite and edit their email in Drupal. If no email is present, email will be driven from LDAP on logon. If an email that conflicts with the LDAP derived email is present, it will not be overwritten.
- ☒ Don't show an email field on user forms. LDAP derived email will be used for user and cannot be changed by user
- ☐ Show disabled email field on user forms with LDAP derived email. LDAP derived email will be used for user and cannot be changed by user
