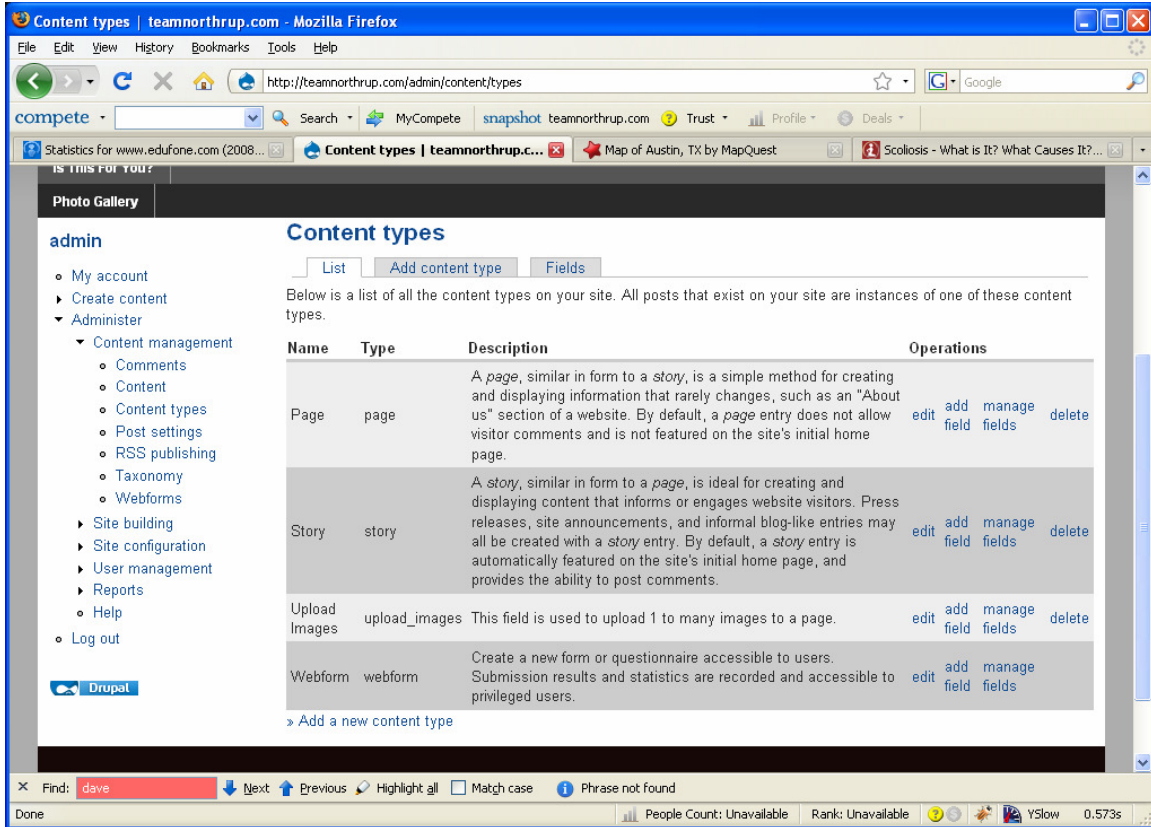


Step 1: Create an imagefield to use later. I used an imceimage. Here's the first page:

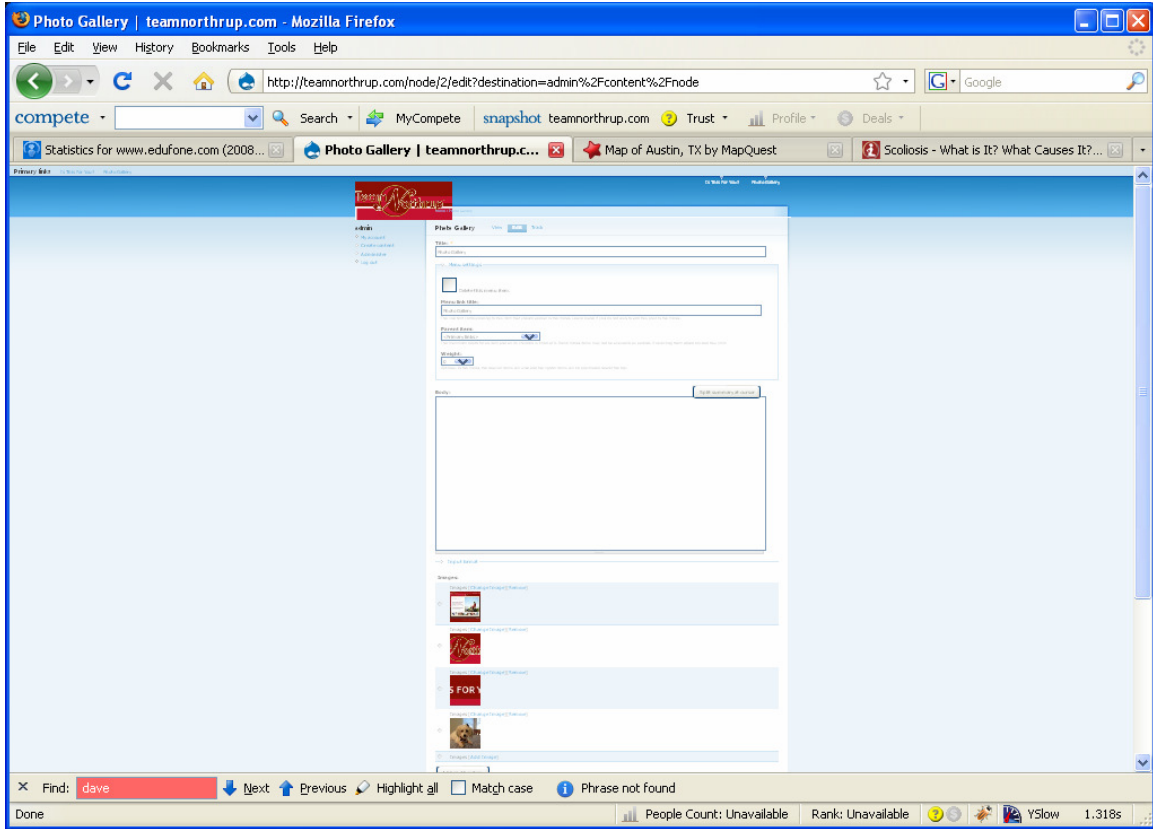
Step 2: Setup jCarousel Block in the admin/settings:
