**amateescu** plach: ping

**plach** ★ amateescu: hy

**plach** ★ hey

**Druplicon** what's up

**amateescu** plach: so I was talking to dawehner about the operation links for edit and delete translation

**plach** ★ yes

**amateescu** plach: and we were wondering if we should use the paths/routes provided by content translation

**amateescu** because they are not user anywhere else

**amateescu** not even node/<nid>/translate doesn't use them :P

**amateescu** it goes to <lang>/node/<nid>/edit

**amateescu** for the translation :)

**amateescu** above is \*not used

**amateescu** instead of not user :)

**plach** ★ not sure baout operation links

**plach** ★ but the translation overview directs you to the edit page or to the translation page (a stripped down entity form with only the translatable fields) depending on your permissions

**amateescu** that's the problem, it doesn't

**amateescu** it directs you to the full edit page with a path prefix

**plach** ★ that's surprising we sued to have test coverage for that

**amateescu** I'm on node/2/translations

**amateescu** two language, en and ro

**plach** ★ you probably have edit permissions

**amateescu** the edit link for the 'ro' translation goes to ro/node/2/edit

**plach** ★ anyway, I think Daniel is right that since we have the concept of translation baked into the Entity API

**amateescu** do I need any special permission even as uid 1?

**plach** ★ the entity operations should be able to deal with translation removal

**plach** ★ as uid 1 you have edit access on the node so you get the edit form

**amateescu** ah

**plach** ★ if you don't have edit permissions you get the translation form

**amateescu** right

**plach** ★ but that's not really relevant, unless I'm issing something

**amateescu** it's not :)

**plach** ★ the translation deletion page is used in both cases

**amateescu** I was just wondering if the translation form is actually used

**plach** ★ or at least is supposed to

**plach** ★ amateescu: it should

**amateescu** plach: it is! :)

**amateescu** nice

**plach** ★ whew

**amateescu** so, if we let entity operations handle it

**amateescu** they just do `$entity->url('delete-form')`

**plach** ★ yes

**amateescu** so we need to return a different url if the active langcode of the entity is not the default one, right?

**plach** ★ or we could make the delete form handle the original entity and the translation objects differently

**amateescu** hmm

**plach** ★

**plach** ★ \* ==

**plach** ★ amateescu: ^

**amateescu** that would remove the translation specific delete form?

**amateescu** ugh

**amateescu** I can't type

**amateescu** does that mean we should remove the translation specific edit form?

**amateescu** \*delete form

**amateescu** or just add the code above to the normal delete form?

**plach** ★ I guess that should make the translation deletion form provided by CT useless

**amateescu** yep, that's what I thought as well

**amateescu** we would need to update the page title too if we remove it though

**amateescu** because the one provided by CT specifies that we're deleting a translation

**plach** ★ Instead CT could alter the deletion-form to display a warning when the whole entity is going to be dleetd

**plach** ★ (and the title :)

**amateescu** the default form is really confusing

**amateescu** it doesn't even say delete in the title

**plach** ★ oops

**amateescu** it's 'Edit Article test article 1 - source - en'

**plach** ★ the delete form??

**amateescu** and the action button is 'Delete (this translation)'

**amateescu** but that's actually the source one

**plach** ★ are you talking about the edit form or the delete form?

**amateescu** I'm not sure in what state it will leave the entity if you delete the source

**amateescu** delete form

**amateescu** node/2/delete

**plach** ★ you can't for now

**plach** ★ we should delete the whole entity

**amateescu** "Article test article 1 - source - en has been deleted."

**plach** ★ the "Fix operation links to deal with translations." paragrpah

**amateescu** got it

**amateescu** so, then for edit

**amateescu** should we go to <lang>/node/<nid>/edit

**amateescu** or the edit page provided by CT?

**amateescu** or that needs to depend on the user permissions, just like the links from the translation overview page

**plach** ★ yep

**plach** ★ translators would not see the edit link

**amateescu** but just the delete link?

**plach** ★ CT might provide an "edit translation" link that would not be visible to people having edit permissions

**plach** ★ the delete link would not be visible either

**plach** ★ again CT could provide a delete translation link

**amateescu** I was thinking that we could just alter the existing links

**plach** ★ but those are not critical

**plach** ★ I think the critical issue is fixing UX for editors

**amateescu** to rename them from 'Edit' to 'Edit translation' if the entity is not the source

**plach** ★ to prevent them from deleting whole entities when they expect to delete single translations

**amateescu** yes

**plach** ★ that would be not consistent with the edit tabs we have all around

**amateescu** but we could fix everything in the same patch, methinks :P

**plach** ★ As you prefer. To recap:

**plach** ★ \* editors see the edit and delete link

**plach** ★ \* translators see "edit translation" / "delete translation" links provided by CT

**plach** ★ we keep CT's translation deletion page

**plach** ★ which does not require edit permissions to be accessed

**plach** ★ but cannot apply to the original enetity

**plach** ★ amateescu: ^

**plach** ★ sounds resoable?

**amateescu** yup :)

**plach** ★ \* reasonable

**amateescu** plach++

**plach** ★ editors should not see edit/delete translation links

**plach** ★ amateescu: awesome, thanks :)

**amateescu** and for editors, the edit link goes to the regular edit form, not the one provided by CT, right?

**plach** ★ yep, exactly

**amateescu** cool
