

Google Summer of Code 2006 Results

What is Summer of Code?

- A program where Google sponsors students to work on an open source project over the summer.
- Overall, more than \$2 million contribution to open source.
- Presents the opportunity for students to become immersed in the open source community.

How does it work?

- Organizations apply to be part of the program, choose “mentors” from the community, brainstorm ideas for projects.
- Google selects organizations to take part.
- Application period is open; students apply to organizations for one of the listed projects or their own.

Then what happens?

- Application period ends, review period begins; organizations review the applications received.
- Organizations sort list of applications from highest to lowest on a variety of factors.
- Review period ends; Google tells each organization, “You get X many slots.”
- Those students in the top X start coding!
