Drupal Steward is a web application firewall that bridges the gap between the time when a security release is announced and when your site is fully updated with the new security patch. This globally distributed service from the Drupal Security Team and the Drupal Association provides immediate, affordable protection for your website, while giving your IT team the flexibility to implement site updates without disrupting other priorities.

### Easy to set up and maintain

Drupal Steward only takes about 20 minutes to set up. Simply go to [drupalsteward.org](https://drupalsteward.org) to subscribe and set up the service. Once you've signed up, protection is automatic.

### Seamless, immediate protection

By routing your domain to Drupal Steward, requests to your site will be automatically filtered through the firewall, where potentially malicious requests will be blocked — no action required from your IT team. You can then schedule testing and implementation of the security update on a timeline that works for you.

### Priced to meet your needs

Drupal Steward is available at different tiers to meet the needs of nonprofits and small organizations, as well as larger enterprises, and pricing scales based on the number of requests served. Sites with fewer than 1 million requests per month can expect to pay around \$25 monthly. Use the calculator on [drupalsteward.org](https://drupalsteward.org) to estimate pricing for your site.
